Change of Major Requirements

The following requirements must be met in order to be accepted into the Department of Animal Science:

1. Complete the required application:

- a. Change of Curriculum Request via Howdy
- b. Include essay incorporating which degree option you plan to pursue and why
- c. Follow change of curriculum deadlines posted by the Registrar's Office on the yearly [Academic Calendar](#) for the relevant semester

2. Complete ANSC 107 and ANSC 108 with a "B" or better in both and:

a. For Production/Industry Option:

- Have at least a **2.75 overall GPA** at Texas A&M.
- Have completed CHEM 119 (CHEM 101 & CHEM 111)
- BIOL 111, MATH 141, MATH 142 are highly preferred.

b. For Science Option:

- Have at least a **3.3 overall GPA** at Texas A&M.
- Have completed CHEM 119 (CHEM 101 & CHEM 111).
**Grade of "B" or better is preferred
- CHEM 120 (CHEM 102 & CHEM 112), MATH 141, MATH 142, and BIOL 111 are highly preferred.

Important Notes

- Typically, students with more than 75 semester credit hours will not be allowed to change majors into the Department of Animal Science.
- Students who are seriously interested in ANSC and may not meet all requirements are encouraged to inquire accordingly.
 - You are applying to a specific option. You may **not** change options after you are admitted.
 - Students are encouraged to complete an in-person (i.e., not web-based) section of ANSC 107.
 - Walk-in advising hours for change of major students are postponed.
